Diplomats back claims Eritrean troops have joined Ethiopia conflict

US official among sources saying soldiers from Eritrea are fighting in operations against Tigray People's Liberation Front



A US official and other diplomatic sources have backed accusations that Eritrean soldiers are fighting alongside Ethiopian troops to help Abiy Ahmed's government in the war on the <u>Tigray People’s Liberation Front</u>

(TPLF), complicating an already dangerous conflict.

The claims made to Reuters, which interviewed several unidentified diplomats in the region and a US official, follow mounting allegations by Tigrayan leaders that Eritrea, long a rival of Ethiopia,

had joined with Ethiopian forces against a common enemy despite denials from both nations.

According to some accounts, thousands of Eritrean troops have joined the conflict during the last month of fighting, while Tigrayan forces have <u>admitted rocketing the Eritrean capital</u>, <u>Asmara</u>.

While <u>refugees crossing into Sudan</u> have also made similar claims, confirmation has been complicated by the lack of access for outsiders, including media, and the cutting of communications to the region.
